

Parent Forum meeting Autumn/Winter 2017

We discussed

Mr Lowbridge-Ellis (Deputy Headteacher) fed back the actions taken since the Summer meeting and asked parents/carers to identify where further action would be welcomed. Ms Draycott (Headteacher) thanked parents/carers for their support in reinforcing uniform expectations.

Mr Lowbridge-Ellis went through the latest Ofsted Parent View responses. The small number of negative responses on Parent View could not be understood by parents/carers in the meeting. The consensus was that this did not reflect their own views of the school.

One of the barriers to completing Parent View is understood to be parents/carers being unwilling to go through the process of signing up with their e-mail addresses. Therefore, a Survey Monkey accessible to everyone has been written by Barr Beacon. Parent Forum members evaluated the proposed survey to be and recommended several additions.

Mr Grocutt (Head of Wrekin House) asked parents/carers for their views on how to further improve praise. Parents and carers loved receiving the praise postcards about their children and would value these being more regular and more timely. They also welcomed suggestions that more verbal gratitude is conveyed to particularly supportive parents/carers.

Mr Lowbridge-Ellis asked how much information parents/carers would value about various aspects of school life. The overwhelming response was that parents/carers trusted the school to do what was best for their children and they assumed everything was going well unless they were notified otherwise. The school website was praised for its clarity and its wealth of useful information. There were some suggestions for developing child-parent dialogue (see right).
