Dear Parents/Carers,

As the end of term is nearly upon us and the preparations for the holiday period begin, can I take this opportunity to remind you of the school rules to help you organise appointments that will no doubt be in high demand.

The school policy states:

- One plain gold or silver stud earring in each ear lobe is permissible no other jewellery is permitted.
- No make-up may be worn by pupils in Years 7, 8 and 9. Pupils in Years 10 and 11 may wear discreet make-up.
- Hair colour and high fashion hairstyles are not permitted. Full and partially shaved heads and shaved eyebrows are also not permitted. No patterns or lines in hair or eyebrows
- Fake tan is not permitted.
- Any extreme fashion, hairstyle or body marking/piercing is banned.
- False nails, false eyelashes and nail polish are not permitted in school.

Please note that pupils who do not follow the rules may not be able to take part in the activities that make the end of term enjoyable. Last year, a number of pupils came to school with hair styles that did not meet requirements; wearing fake tan and/ or false nails. They were subsequently isolated. Please do not make appointments for your child before the end of term on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> December after 1.30pm.

Can I also remind you that salt is not allowed in school at any time. We follow guidance from the Department for Education which states: 'Salt must not be available to add to food after it has been cooked'. I would ask that you discuss with your child the necessity to moderate salt intake as part of a healthy diet. If a pupil is found to have salt, it will be confiscated.
