Pupils' login and password details for Microsoft Teams are the same as those they use to login to their school email account. If they have forgotten these details, email itsupport@barrbeaconschool.co.uk.

Microsoft Teams is a way for your child to stay in touch with their teachers for guidance and feedback regarding their work. Please make it clear to your child that **this is not a social space** but an online learning environment. Pupils must not use this for conversations with their peers as this is for discussions regarding the work set by the teachers. If a pupil does have a concern they can message their Head of House on Microsoft Teams or via their school email account.

Thank you for all of your feedback about the **audio-visual resources** we added to our online learning this week. Teachers have spent a long time making these and we know many pupils are finding them useful. The audio-visual resources are located in the All Resources folders with all of the other resources for each subject. If your child is having trouble locating a resource or is having difficulty with any of the work they have been set they need to contact their teacher for that subject.
