Duke of Edinburgh Award Bronze Practice Expedition 2021

I am pleased to provide final confirmation that the Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award practice expeditions will go ahead as planned in the letter sent to you on 29th January 2021.

The practice expeditions taking place on the 21st-22nd May 2021 and 11th-12th June 2021 will be carried out at Barr Beacon School and Sutton Park. On Friday 21st May, participants should arrive at school for 8:00am with all their expedition equipment packed in their rucksack.
