Dear Parents and Carers

As we near the end of our first full week back at school, I wanted to thank everyone who has done everything possible to work with us and to make the new routines and procedures operate as intended.



Here are some things we need everyone to be aware of so we can fine-tune these routines and further minimise the risk of viral transmission.

In addition, they require aprons when completing practical work in Food Technology and Textiles. For Years 7, 8 and 9 these are on a rotation and pupils will be notified when aprons are required.
