



BARR BEACON SCHOOL – COVID GUIDELINES

<u>What to do if....</u>	<u>Actions needed</u>	<u>Return to school when....</u>
....my child has Covid-19 symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not send your child into school • Inform Postbox immediately • Self-isolate the whole household • Get a test for the child with symptoms. Forward the test results as soon as they are available to school postbox@barrbeaconschool.co.uk the test comes back negative or a period of 10 days has passed since the symptoms started and the child feels well.
....my child tests positive for Covid-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not send your child into school • Self-isolate the whole household • Forward the test results immediately via email to Postbox postbox@barrbeaconschool.co.uk 10 days have passed since the test was taken or since symptoms began, even if they have a cough or loss of taste/smell (these symptoms can last for several weeks) AND the child feels well and has a normal temperature.
....my child tests negative for Covid-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact school to inform us via Postbox • Forward the test results as soon as they are available to school via email to Postbox postbox@barrbeaconschool.co.uk the test comes back negative
....my child is ill with symptoms not linked to Covid-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your child should not come to school if they do not feel well enough to attend, or if they have had sickness and/or diarrhoea • Contact child's House Office to inform • Contact school on each day of absence unless a medical note has been provided feeling well enough to attend and/or after 48 hours following the last bout of sickness and diarrhoea
....someone in my household tests positive for Covid-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not send your child into school • Contact school to inform us via Postbox • Self-isolate the whole household • Household member to get a test Forward the test results as soon as they are available to school via email to Postbox postbox@barrbeaconschool.co.uk the test comes back negative



<p>....Someone in my household tests positive for Covid-19</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not send your child into school • Contact school via Postbox • Self-isolate the whole household. Forward the test results as soon as they are available to school via email to Postbox <p>postbox@barrbeaconschool.co.uk</p>	<p>....the child had completed 14 days of isolation</p>
<p>....NHS Test and Trace has identified my child as a close contact of someone with symptoms or confirmed Covid-19</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not send your child into school • Contact school to inform us via Postbox • Send any information received from NHS Test and Trace <p>postbox@barrbeaconschool.co.uk</p>	<p>....the child has completed 14 days of isolation</p>
<p>....NHS Test and Trace has identified a household member (other than my child) as a close contact of someone with symptoms or confirmed Covid-19</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The household member must self-isolate for 14 days • Your child can continue to attend school 	<p>....the child can continue to attend school</p>
<p>....a sibling (brother or sister) attending another school has been sent home to self-isolate due to there being a positive case in school</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sibling must isolate for 14 days • Barr Beacon pupil can continue to attend 	<p>....the child can continue to attend school</p>
<p>....my child has travelled from a country or territory that is NOT on the exempt list of countries</p>	<p>If returning from a destination where quarantine is needed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum of 14 days self-isolation for all those who travelled • Contact school to inform us where you travelled from and the date you arrived back in the UK • Self-isolate the whole household <p>postbox@barrbeaconschool.co.uk</p>	<p>....the quarantine period of 14 days has been completed</p>



<p>....my child has travelled from a country or territory that IS on the exempt list of countries</p>	<p>If returning from a destination where quarantine is NOT needed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check current exempt countries and territories list to confirm the country you have travelled from is on the exempt list <p>https://www.gov.uk/foreign-travel-advice</p>	<p>....the child can attend school</p>
<p>....I have travelled from a country that requires us to quarantine (but my child didn't travel)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • As long as you do not have/have not had symptoms in the last 14 days, your child can continue to attend school • The person who travelled MUST NOT leave the house including to do pick-ups and drop-offs 	<p>....the child can continue to attend school</p>
<p>....we have received medical advice that my child must remain shielding</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not send your child to school • Contact school to inform us via Postbox • Forward a copy of the shielding letter to school via email to Postbox • Shield until you are informed that restrictions are lifted and shielding is paused again <p>postbox@barrbeaconschool.co.uk</p>	<p>....restrictions have been lifted and your child can return to school again</p> <p>....you receive medical advice that your child may return to school</p>
<p>....my child has been asked by Barr Beacon School to self-isolate</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not send your child to school • Support your child at home with remote education provided by school • Your child will need to self-isolate. A text will be sent by school to inform you of the date your child is to return to school • Other siblings may continue to attend school 	<p>....school informs you via text of the date of return</p>

<p>How to self-isolate</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not go to work, school or public places – work from home if you can • Do not go on public transport or use taxis • Do not go out to get food and medicine – order it online or by phone, or ask someone to bring it to your home • Do not have visitors in your home, including family and friends – except for people providing essential care • Do not go out to exercise – exercise at home or in your garden, if you have one <p>https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/self-isolation-and-treatment/when-to-self-isolate-and-what-to-do/</p>
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Home Learning	<p>If your child needs to isolate, they can keep up with their learning by logging in to Microsoft Teams using their school email account. Any other email account will not work.
