<p>Curriculum Rationale: Our French curriculum has two clear aims: firstly, to create confident and flexible communicators who use their skills in the foreign language to express themselves, share their ideas and opinions, and communicate in real life situations. We want pupils to develop spoken and written skills such as spontaneity and discussion development alongside strong grammatical knowledge and have a wide breadth of vocabulary and structures at their disposal. Secondly, we want to ignite pupils' natural curiosity for the wider world. We want our lessons to be a window into the culture and society of communities beyond our doorstep and encourage pupils to understand the importance of recognising and celebrating our cultural and linguistic differences. Pupils will learn how important it is to accept and celebrate all our differences and how embracing others' cultures can really enrich our own lives.</p>
