Walsall School Nursing Team – Sexual Health Presentation

On Thursday, 16th June 2022, there will be a presentation on Teenage Pregnancy from the Walsall School Nursing Team. This will be delivered in the school hall and will last approximately 20 minutes. Year 9 and Year 10 will be in separate sessions.

The Department for Education's Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) states that all pupils should learn about pregnancy options and contraception before they leave secondary school. The Relationships Education, Relationships and Sex Education, and Health Education (England) Regulations 2019 are made under sections 34 and 35 of the Children and Social Work Act 2017. Relationships Education is compulsory in all primary schools in England and Relationships and Sex Education compulsory in all secondary schools. Health Education is compulsory in all state-funded schools. RSE is not about the promotion of sexual activity, it seeks to support and prepare pupils for adult life.

If you do not wish your child to take part in the presentation, please inform your child's House Office by Monday 13th June 2022.
