As we approach the end of the term, I write to share some important information for the new academic year 2022/23; share some reminders about expectations and to thank you for the support you have given throughout this year, which has again seen many challenges.

### **Discovery Week:**

As you know pupils will be completing Discovery Week between Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> July – 21<sup>st</sup> Thursday unless they are on an International Trip that departs sooner. Please refer to the individual letters that have been shared from group leaders for these activities about departure times and requirements. I am sure that the pupils are very much looking forward to their chosen activities and I hope that they enjoy the end of term. However, a reminder that if any pupil does not follow the expectations that have been clearly shared with them, pupils will not be able to participate and will instead be removed from the activities.

School is closed to pupils on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2022.

#### New Term 2022/23 and Changes to the School Day:

The new term begins on Wednesday 7th September for years 8, 9, 10 11 and year 13. Year 7 and 12 start on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> September. We have made some changes to the school day in the light of the Department for Education's White Paper 2022, which requires schools to offer a 'richer, longer' school week. Therefore, the school day will be as follows:

Extra Curricular, Catch Up & Redos commence from 3.15pm and end at 4.15pm	





As you can see we have an earlier start and slightly later end to the day. The bus company has been informed and the routes have been adapted to meet our requirements. Pupils should adjust their departure times to ensure that they can arrive on site ready to start the day at the earlier time of 8.35am.

## **School Uniform:**

I would also bring your attention to the school website which has reminders about expectations for school uniform including skirts, trousers and school shoes. You will remember that we introduced the skirts and trousers which hold the school emblem for pupils in September 2022, to challenge the short skirts and skin-tight trousers that some supermarkets sell as 'school uniform'. I appreciate that the cost of living is high and that there are ever increasing demands on incomes. In the light of the current challenges faced by us all, it has been decided that from September the branded items are optional. However, I reiterate that the same expectations of uniform are in place. We have plenty of spare, new and clean uniform which we can loan to pupils who do not follow the uniform policy. ## **Price Increase School Meals:**

The cost of living is also impacting on the price of food. I have written to you during the year to explain the challenges that we have faced in school in sourcing food to fulfil our menu offer. Unfortunately, given the rising cost of ingredients, we are having to increase the price of meals on offer. Currently, a meal deal which includes a main meal and a 250ml bottle of water costs £2.00. From September, we will charge £2.20 for this. Other price increases will be made and will be available on the website.

Pupils in receipt of Free School Meals currently have £1.00 allocation at break time. This will now be reduced to 80p to ensure that pupils can buy food and drink and have sufficient allocation to purchase a meal deal at lunch time. At break a deal including toast and a drink will be available for the 80p allocation.
