Duke of Edinburgh – Silver Award 2022-23

We are delighted to offer your child the opportunity to complete the Silver Duke of Edinburgh Award as part of Discovery Week at Barr Beacon School.

This is a prestigious award that provides pupils with the opportunity to develop their leadership and teamwork skills as well as their resilience and organisation. This is an impressive accolade to add to their CV and will be a huge draw for potential employers. This a real commitment and pupils will be expected to attend several after school sessions and training sessions beforehand. Pupils will also have to complete the different sections of the award. These will be done in their own time. Please click here to find out more information on the different sections of the award. If pupils do not attend these sessions regularly, and/or meet deadlines given, they will not be allowed to go on the expedition during Discovery Week.

The Silver Award is a step up from the Bronze Award. However, if you have not already completed the Bronze Award you can still complete the Silver Award. More information on timescales and the different sections can be found here.

The <u>practice expedition</u> will take place from F<u>riday 28th April – Sunday 30th April 2023</u>. Friday will consist of a training day to refresh your child's knowledge and develop their expedition skills further. Your child will then go to the Long Mynd area of Shropshire and spend 2 days walking and developing their expedition skills. If your child did not participate in the Bronze Award, they will need to attend some additional training sessions.

The <u>qualifying expedition</u> will take place during Discovery Week 17th – 21st July 2023. Pupils will spend Monday planning their routes and refreshing their expedition knowledge and skills. Pupils will then spend Tuesday-Thursday out on expedition in the Peak District. On Friday they will complete a presentation with their group to discuss what they learnt whilst on expedition.

The cost of the award is £130. This includes the registration fee, camp sites fees for practice expedition and the expedition during Discovery Week, a training day, petrol costs and group equipment hire including tents and cooking equipment.

You will need to pay a £30 **non-refundable** deposit on Wisepay to secure your child's place on the award. This must be paid by Friday 11th November 2022. Can we please reiterate this deposit is **non-refundable**, and if your child decides later to discontinue with the award, no part of the deposit will be reimbursed. The final payment of £100 will be due by the 28^{th} November 2022.


