



**Curriculum intent:** Our curriculum provides pupils with the knowledge and experiences which will interest and empower them to take languages on to further study, giving them the opportunity to thrive in the multilingual workplace and make informed contributions to our democratic society

**Curriculum rationale:** There are two clear aims of our curriculum.
