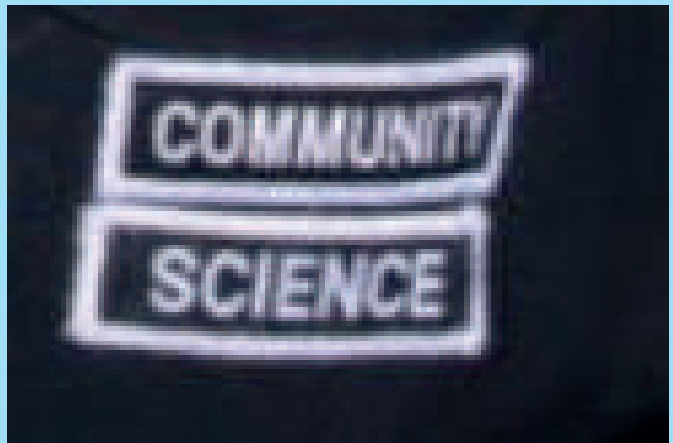

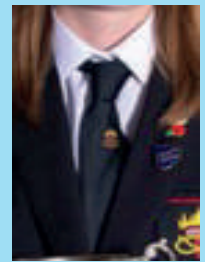

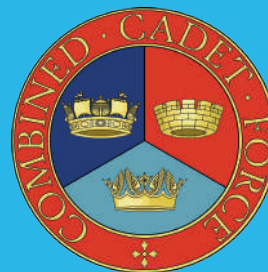

Resilience Award (HOH)

This is awarded to any pupil who has shown great resilience in overcoming a difficulty that might have hindered their progress at school.

Service to the school Award (HOH)
