



**Curriculum Overview 20204-2025**

**Curriculum intent:** *Our curriculum provides pupils with the knowledge and experiences which will interest and empower them to take languages on to further study, giving them the opportunity to thrive in the multilingual workplace and make informed contributions to our democratic society*

**Curriculum rationale:** *There are two clear aims of our curriculum. Firstly, to create confident and flexible communicators who use their skills in the foreign language to express themselves, share their ideas and communicate in real life situations. We want pupils to develop spoken and written skills such as spontaneity and discussion alongside a strong grammatical understanding. Secondly, we want to ignite pupils’ natural curiosity for the wider world. We want our lessons to be a window into the cultural and society of communities beyond our doorstep and encourage pupils to understand the importance of recognising and celebrating our cultural and linguistic differences. Pupils will learn how important it is to accept and celebrate all our differences and how embracing others’ cultures can enrich our own lives*
