### **Macmillan Coffee Morning 2024**

Dear Parent/Carer,

Friday 27<sup>th</sup> September marks the National Tea and Coffee Morning to raise money for Macmillan Cancer Support. Last year Macmillan raised over £12 million and we would like to support them to do even better this year!

On the 27<sup>th</sup> September only, we will accept cash payments for cakes. If your child would like to donate in exchange for a cake, please send in your child with some money so that they are able to purchase cakes from the bistro at break time.

Pupils can take part in the following two ways:

1. **Inter-house Cake Decoration Competition**

Decorate a cake or cupcakes in the style of their House. This might mean reflecting the House colour or the House mascot (Bredon - Bear, Clent - Snake, Wrekin - Lion, Malvern - Dragon). We would like to encourage pupils to be creative in celebrating their House! We will award 5 House Points each for participation and 10 House Points for pupils in each House achieving 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> prize for decoration. Cakes that have been decorated for the competition will not be consumed. Pupils will be able to collect them at the end of the day and bring them home.

2. **Bring in 'shop-bought' cakes for sale**

Pupils can also take part by contributing shop purchased cakes to be sold in the coffee morning.

We ask that pupils bring in their competition entries or cakes for sale to the Bistro before school on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> September during form time. The Macmillan Coffee Morning epitomises our Beacon value of 'Consideration for Others'. Our pupils routinely show this valuable character trait and show compassion and consideration for those around them. We look forward to raising money as a school community and thank you in advance for your support of the event.
