## <u>Year 12 Work Experience Week</u> <u>Monday 14<sup>th</sup> to Friday 18<sup>th</sup> July 2025</u>



Work experience has long been recognised as one of the best ways to help young people prepare for the world of work. It can help students to get a taste of the workplace, expand their networks and gain transferable skills to support their future university or apprenticeship applications.

Year 12 Work Experience Week will be taking place on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> to Friday 18<sup>th</sup> July 2025. We are making you aware of these dates now, as students must start approaching employers early in order to secure a valuable placement. Work Experience is compulsory for all students and, although students are responsible for finding their own placements, the school will give students advice and offer additional support where needed.

It is important to keep in mind that:

- Employers must have Employer's Liability Insurance and health and safety procedures in place.
- Students must not work after 10.00pm or before 7.00am and must not work for more than 8 hours a day.
- Students must have a 30 minute break for any shift lasting more than 4.5 hours and must have at least 12 hours off between each working day.

When your child has secured their placement, please complete this <a href="Parent/Carer Form">Parent/Carer Form</a> and your child will need to ask their employer to complete the <a href="Employer Form">Employer Form</a>. The deadline to complete these forms is Friday 31<sup>st</sup> January 2025. Both forms must be completed or the placement will not be able to go ahead.

We will prepare students for their placement in the summer term and school staff will visit students during their placement (or make contact where a visit isn't possible) to ensure everything is going well.
