Please find below all final information for the Whitemoor Lakes trip. We will meet with the pupils on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> January 2025 in Period 5 at 2.45pm to go through final expectations.

# **Departure from Barr Beacon School**

Pupils will attend school as normal on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> January 2025. They may attend in their outdoor wear, ready for the trip. This should be sensible and warm clothes, layers and outdoor shoes. Pupils can drop their bags to the Community Lounge, above the Dance Studio at the start of the day. They can check in with Miss Porter and arrive through the bus bay, where they will be directed to where they can safely leave their bags for the trip. We will meet at 10.30am by the sports hall entrance and depart at 11.00am from school to Whitemoor Lakes.

<u>Pupils should bring their own packed lunch</u> with them on the day as we will eat onsite at the venue. The first cooked meal on offer will be at dinner time.

## Arrival back to Barr Beacon School

#### **Medication**

#### **Evening entertainment**

After pupils have had their dinner, they will take part in 'Extreme Teams' or the 'Camp fire' activity. From 8.00 – 9.00 pm, we will offer a choice of two evening entertainments before the bedtime curfew of 9.30pm. Pupils will go to their rooms at around 9.00pm to get ready for bed.
