This assembly is a part of the statutory **RSHE** (Relationships and Sexual Health Education) curriculum, which requires that all students receive education on the topic of FGM as part of their safeguarding. It is compulsory for students to engage with this content and we believe that it is an important part of their education to ensure they are aware of their rights and the support available to them.

Please be assured that the content of the session will be delivered in a sensitive and ageappropriate manner and there will be opportunities for students to ask questions and seek support where necessary.
