



**Curriculum intent:** The Media curriculum has been designed to enhance and develop creative media skills with a specific focus in film production. **Curriculum rationale:** For level 2 Media, the BTEC course is linear and split into three components taught over two years. As components progress, pupils will move onto planning, creating and evaluating their own media products.
