Year 11 Attendance

Dear Parent / Carer,

From today, Friday 6th June, year 11 pupils are not required to attend school unless they have an examination.

On Monday 9th June, all pupils have the GCSE Biology Paper. Following the exam pupils will have a break and will then attend a study session with their maths teachers in preparation for Paper 3 Maths exam on Wednesday morning. All pupils are expected to attend this final revision session. Pupils will then be dismissed at 12.30pm from the gate on Old Hall Lane. A study session will take place before the Maths exam on Wednesday morning in the Bistro.

On Monday 9th June, if your child studies GCSE PE or GCSE Italian they will do a study session P3 and then be required to stay on site until after their exam has finished. They will be dismissed from the exam hall.

There are no exams on Tuesday 10th June. If pupils wish to attend school for a lesson which they have an exam they are yet to take, they must enter the site via the top gate and sign in and out at reception so we can record their presence in case of an emergency. Pupils must wear full school uniform. Pupils should not wander around school when they do not have a lesson. If a pupil has lesson they wish to attend in the morning and afternoon, they can leave site and return.

A reminder that the Leaver's Assembly will be held on Monday 16th June. Pupils will leave site at approximately 1.00pm. School buses will not be provided at this time so arrangements should be made for them to travel home.

This time of year can be filled with many different emotions including the excitement of leaving; we ask that when pupils leave site they demonstrate the Beacon Value of acting responsibly and go directly home.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support for your child during their time at Barr Beacon School. Some of our learners will be starting a new journey Post 16 and we wish them every success. We look forward to welcoming back pupils and families in September as they embark on their studies in our Sixth Form.

I will write again before the end of term with details about collection of examination results in August.
