

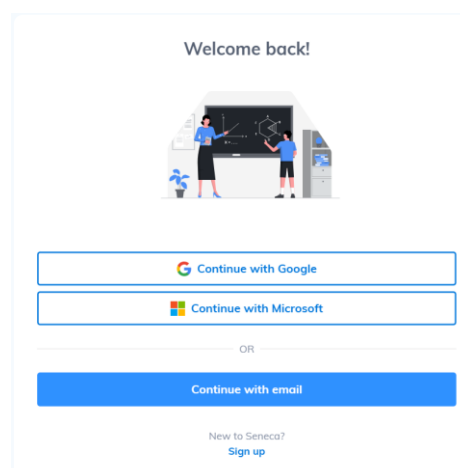

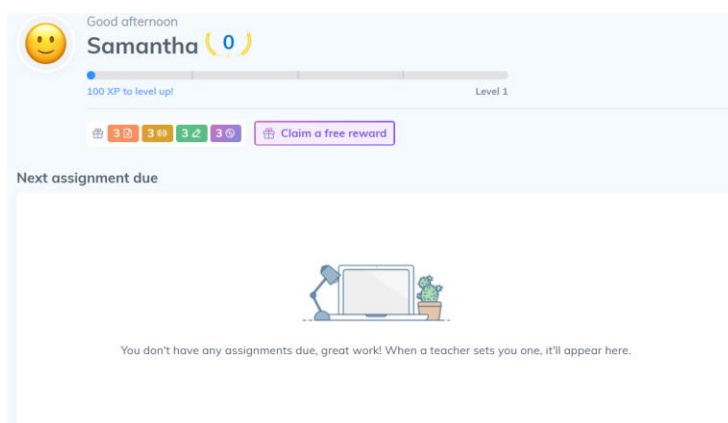
When signing up to Seneca we suggest selecting the option to “Continue with Microsoft”. This will link your account to your school email account and password.



Seneca Home Screen

Your Seneca Home Screen will show you several statistics about your work on Seneca, including XP which reflects the amount of time spent using Seneca and the number of questions answered.

You will also see details of any assignments teachers have set you that are due soon.



Adding Courses

You don't need to wait for an assignment to be issued to you, you can choose to study any course on Seneca to support your independent revision.

To add a new course, scroll down to the My Subjects section of your home screen and select manage.



On the following screen you have the option to pick the level of your study e.g. KS3, GCSE, A Level, and the subject you wish to study. Seneca will then enrol you onto the relevant course.

If selecting a GCSE, A Level or BTEC course ensure you are selecting the correct exam board as content differs between exam boards. If you are unsure which exam board you are studying, check with your teacher first.
