We would be grateful if you could reinforce the following expectations with your child:

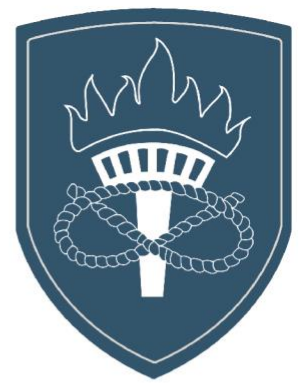
- Travel directly to school in the morning and return home promptly at the end of the school day.
