As well as providing information about our personal development curriculum, we are also regularly post good news stories to show the activities, workshops and charity events that pupils are involved with. In addition to this, we include events in our half termly newsletter which is sent out on WEDUC to all parents and carers.

In preparation for the change to the new RSHE guidance, we will also be offering family engagement sessions throughout the year and signposting support for caregivers to discuss RSHE topics at home. These will be shared with you in due course.
