Pupils selecting an offsite activity will need to make payment via WEDUC.

- Payments open: *6.00pm on Friday 5th December*
- Final deadline for all payments: *Tuesday 7th January 2026 at 4.00pm*

Payments must be made in full by 7th January as a number of sites and coach companies now require payment upfront to secure tickets. If full payment is not made, the place will be released to other pupils.

When paying on WEDUC the full amount must be paid to secure the place. You are not able to pay a contribution to secure the place.

Please note that payments are non-refundable, except where medical evidence is provided.

Offsite trips are extremely popular, and places will sell out quickly. Unfortunately, we cannot add additional places once trips are full.

If a trip sells out, you may email postbox@barrbeaconschool.co.uk to request that your child be added to a waiting list. We will contact you if a place becomes available.

Onsite Activities

Pupils who choose to remain onsite will still need to select their preferred activities via WEDUC. If no selection is made, pupils will be allocated to available activities, which may not match their preferences. We therefore encourage all pupils to make their selections promptly once the system opens. There is no cost associated with these events.

Behaviour Expectations

Participation in both onsite and offsite activities is a privilege. Pupils who receive serious sanctions during the Spring or Summer term may be removed from their chosen trip, and this decision will be final. In addition, pupils with behaviour ratios of 90% or below will be considered by the behaviour team and may be removed. Their places will be forfeited, and we will open up the space to a pupil on the waiting list.

Final decisions regarding pupil eligibility will be made by 15th June 2026, based on behaviour throughout the year. We appreciate your support in encouraging positive conduct and responsibility in the lead-up to this event. We celebrate the vast majority of our pupils who endorse our values and are proud to succeed. We will not allow the behaviour of the minority to jeopardise enjoyment of this day.
