As we begin the new academic year, we would like to inform you of some changes to our homework policy.

Our revised approach has been designed to support pupils in developing their independent learning skills gradually throughout their journey with us. We believe that building these skills over time will help pupils become more confident, organised and resilient learners, while preparing them for future study and life beyond school.

Which subjects will my child have homework for?

In Year 10, homework will be set by each subject once per week. This means that pupils will receive weekly homework in Mathematics, English and Science set for pupils on a Thursday and due the following Thursday at 8:30am, meaning these should be completed before they come to school on this day.

Pathways subjects will also set one task per week according to the schedule below:

Block A – Set on a Wednesday, due the following Wednesday at 8:30am

Block B – Set on a Tuesday, due the following Tuesday at 8:30am

Block C – Set on a Monday, due the following Monday at 8:30am

Pupils are encouraged to make regular use of the knowledge organisers and other resources provided by all subjects to support their learning and prepare effectively for assessments.

Homework will continue to be communicated through Class Charts, allowing both parents and pupils to access homework tasks, deadlines and any supporting information in one place.

This year, we are also introducing Sparx for English and Science homework. Sparx provides an interactive online platform that offers personalised learning and immediate feedback, helping pupils to practise and consolidate their knowledge independently. Whilst Maths homework will be set on Dr Frost, pupils will also have access to Sparx Maths to support additional revision and practice.

To help pupils plan their workload, a homework timetable will be issued in September. This will outline the days on which each subject will set homework, enabling pupils and families to establish consistent routines at home.

We are also pleased to continue offering our Homework Club, which will run every evening in the iCentre until 4:00 pm and until 3:30pm on Friday. Homework Club is available to all pupils and provides:



- Support with homework tasks.
- A quiet and focused space to work.
- Access to computers and school resources.
- Help with any other homework-related questions or concerns.

We encourage pupils to make full use of this provision, particularly if they need additional support or would benefit from completing their homework before leaving school.

We appreciate your continued support in encouraging positive study habits at home. By working together, we can help our pupils develop the independence and confidence they need to achieve their full potential.
