Homework- Year 9

As we begin the new academic year, we would like to inform you of some changes to our homework policy.

Our revised approach has been designed to support pupils in developing their independent learning skills gradually throughout their journey with us. We believe that building these skills over time will help pupils become more confident, organised and resilient learners, while preparing them for future study and life beyond school.

Which subjects will my child have homework for?

In Year 9, homework will be set only in Maths, English and Science until October Half Term, allowing them an opportunity to become familiar with new online platforms that will be used. After October Half Term they will also be set homework in Languages. All homework tasks will be set for pupils on a Wednesday and will be due the following Wednesday at 8:30am, meaning these should be completed before they come to school on this day.

After Christmas, Humanities homework will be introduced. This will mean from January until the end of the academic year, pupils will receive homework in the following subjects:

- Maths
- English
- Science
- French or German (depending on their language of study)
- History
- Geography
- RE

Pupils are encouraged to make regular use of the knowledge organisers and other resources provided by all subjects to support their learning and prepare effectively for assessments.

Homework will continue to be communicated through Class Charts, allowing both parents and pupils to access homework tasks, deadlines and any supporting information in one place.

This year, we are also introducing Sparx for Maths, English and Science homework. Sparx provides an interactive online platform that offers personalised learning and immediate feedback, helping pupils to practise and consolidate their knowledge independently.

To help pupils plan their workload, a homework timetable will be issued in September. This will outline the days on which each subject will set homework, enabling pupils and families to establish consistent routines at home.
